Dear Sanborn Students and Families,


With school starting this week, we wanted to be sure to remind students about the dress code, and the electronic device policies.

Dress Code:

Please see the image below and reference the school policies in the student handbook for student expectations on how to properly dress for school. The entire area from armpit to mid-thigh should be covered; any see-through materials and rips should NOT be in this area. Undergarments should not be visible. Please help us maintain an environment conducive to learning and help our students prepare for the next chapter in their lives whether it be the workforce, military, college, or wherever else their ambitions take them by practicing discipline in dressing for school so they are dressed for success and ready to take on the world!

Students violating the dress code will receive a warning and be asked to change. If a change of clothes cannot be brought, the incident will be documented in disciplinary records and a second violation will result in further disciplinary action. Parents and guardians will not be called regarding dress code violations but will receive an email by the end of the school day the violation occurred. Responses to dress code violations are restorative. Students are given an opportunity to self-correct or get parental support when they are not following the dress code.

For students who repeatedly violate the dress code and/or refuse to comply with the dress code, the disciplinary team will apply the appropriate Sanborn code of conduct and restorative consequence(s).



Electronic Devices:

The Board recognizes that many students possess cell phones and other electronic devices that they wish to carry at school. These devices may not be used at school and/or during school activities in any manner that disrupts the educational process or school environment, or that violates Board policies or school rules.

This year staff will be requiring students to place their phones in a numbered phone pouch during academic time. The administration will be supporting staff in their efforts. Phones are not permitted to be used in the hallways or bathrooms while classes are in session. Breakfast time, passing time, and lunch time are acceptable times for students to use their phones.




