The beginning of the year is a whirlwind for the counseling office. However, schedule changes are complete and students seem to be settling into their classes. Counselors have been reaching out to parents of students who have 504 plans to review the plans and schedule meetings. If your child has a 504 plan and you would like to update the plan, please reach out to their school counselor to schedule a meeting.

Senior Post-High School Planning Kickoff! There are many events happening for Seniors in September.

- ★ On September 18th at 6pm in the SRHS library. We will be talking about the changes to the Financial Aid process, Scoir the online college and career planning tool, College Guidance Network, the Common Application and Letters of Recommendation. Counselors will be hosting weekly college labs during advisory/academic work time block to help students with their college search process.
- ★ On September 20th, SRHS will host our Annual College Fair. Over 65 colleges, the military, trade schools and technical programs as well as GAP year programs will be represented at the fair. All students will have an opportunity to visit the fair and ask questions.
- ★ On September 21st, we will have our Academic Awards night. Invitations to the awards ceremony will be arriving in the mail soon.
- ★ On October 16th at 6pm in the library, we will host the NH Higher Education Assistance Foundation and they will present a thorough overview of the changes in the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You will definitely not want to miss this presentation if your student is heading off to either a 2 year or 4 year college.
- ★ Finally, all Seniors will be having individual meetings with their school counselor to sign an intent to graduate form. Students will identify the type of diploma they will be earning and they will identify any requirements outside the school day that need to be completed in order to walk across the stage in June.
