SUPERVISION AND SAFETY OF STUDENTS

The Board is committed to ensuring that students are appropriately supervised at times when the District is responsible for providing students with a reasonable duty of care and supervision.

The building Principal is responsible for administering and supervising the school, the general conduct of students, both on school premises and during school-sponsored activities off school grounds. Students should be under the supervision of a member of the school staff at all reasonable times while they are in school or attending school functions. In some cases, students may be supervised by approved volunteers / chaperones on school sponsored field trips or during school activities. All school staff shall ensure the safety of students even when they are not specifically scheduled for supervisory duty.

All dangerous conditions in the school should be reported at once to the Building Principal.

In schools where bus transportation is provided the supervisory duties shall include the loading and unloading, when necessary of the students at the school. Elementary school students shall be supervised during boarding and discharging to ensure safety.

The Building Principal is authorized to establish administrative rules and/or regulations in furtherance of this policy.
