SEARCHES OF STUDENT AUTOMOBILES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

Statement of Policy:

Students recognize that parking their automobiles on school property is a privilege and not a right. As part of this privilege, the district may search students' automobiles while parked on school property if the district has reasonable suspicion that a violation of school rules or policy has occurred. Students consent to having their automobiles searched by parking in school parking lots.

In the event that an employee of the school district has reason to believe that drugs, drug paraphernalia, or weapons are present in a student's automobile, that employee will inform the building principal or his/her designee, who will then conduct a search of the automobile.

If the student refuses to allow his/her vehicle to be searched, and/or acts in any manner that threatens the safety or well-being of district employees or students, school officials are authorized to contact local law enforcement authorities and turn over all necessary investigative procedures to them.
